
Scriptures to pray into regarding the Coronavirus

We need to return to the Torah of Yeshua!

- lest I come and smite the earth with a curse. Malachi 4:10






Prayer Target: Adhering to the Torah or following the terms of the alliance is not only protection and preservation, but it is also a dam against the flood of evil. What the verse below is saying is that if we don't turn back to our spiritual fathers who preached the Torah, He will curse the earth. The prophet Malachi, the messenger of His Covenant, reminds us of this with a big warning:

Scripture: "Remember the Torah of my servant Moses, the statutes and rules that I commanded him at Horeb for all Israel. "Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the great and awesome day of the Lord comes. And he will turn the hearts of the fathers to their children and the hearts of children to their fathers, lest I come and strike the land with a decree of utter destruction." (Malachi 4-6)



Prayer Target: Abba, we stand in the gap and we repent for transgressing your Torah, your Holy word and covenant. We confess that we have not followed or obeyed your Torah. Your word says that sin is the transgression of the Torah (1 John 3:4). We return to your Torah with all our heart! We purpose and choose to follow the Torah of Yeshua our Messiah by the power of the indwelling Holy Spirit. We ask you to have mercy upon us! **Torah = whole bible from Genesis to Revelation.**

Scripture: Behold, the Lord makes the earth empty, and makes it waste, and turns it upside down, and scatters abroad the inhabitants thereof,. And it shall be, as with the people. so with The priest; as with the servant, so with his master; as with the buyer, so with the seller, as with the taker of usury, so with the giver of usury to him. The land shall be utterly emptied, and utterly spoiled: for The Lord has spoken this word. The earth mourns and fades away, The world languishes and fades away, the haughty people of the earth do languish. The earth also is defiled under the inhabitants thereof; because they have transgressed the Torah, changed the ordinance, and broken the everlasting covenant. Therefore has the curse devoured the earth and they that dwell therein are desolate; therefore the inhabitants of the earth are burned and few men are left." (Isa.24:1-6)



Prayer Target: Abba, as much of the world is "sheltering in" at home right now, Abba, we choose to shelter under your wings at this time. We trust in you.

Scripture verse: He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust."


Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler

He shall cover you with His feathers,


And under His wings you shall take refuge;

His truth shall be your shield and buckler. Psalm 91:1-4






Scripture verse: LORD, my heart is not haughty, Nor my eyes lofty.

O Israel, hope in the LORD


From this time forth and forever. Psalm 131:1-3
